Buck and Milburn began collaborating whilst living in Tokyo in 2002 with their audio visual project Mink Engine. Together their multi-disciplinary work has been shown widely around the world. As artists and producers their work explores the relationship between sound and pictures.

ALIENESE 24 HOUR is a new video work that explores the internet of you, me, them and whatever is now, summed up perfectly in a quote by sampling artist *Girl Talk* 'We're all the same dude, dude". ALIENESE 24 HOUR is audio visual Collagism, a new language that describes now.
